A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to justification and excuse, so as to provide for immunity from criminal liability for
- 3 possession of certain materials or images under certain circumstances; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 justification and excuse, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "16-3-22.1.
- 10 (a) Any person that in good faith has possession of materials or images in violation of
- 11 Article 3 of Chapter 12 of this title and immediately notifies law enforcement officials or
- any person that is required by Code Section 19-7-5 to report suspected child abuse, or
- makes such notification within 72 hours from the time there is reasonable cause to believe
- such person is in possession of such materials or images, shall be immune to the same
- 15 <u>extent as a law enforcement officer would be immune from criminal liability for such</u>
- 16 <u>possession.</u>
- 17 (b) The official report of the law enforcement agency or the Division of Family and
- 18 <u>Children Services of the Department of Human Services shall create a rebuttable</u>
- 19 <u>presumption of good faith and reasonableness on the part of the person that has possession.</u>
- 20 (c) The purpose of this Code section is to provide for those persons that act in good faith
- 21 <u>to assist law enforcement officers or the Division of Family and Children Services of the</u>
- 22 <u>Department of Human Services when the health and safety of a child are being adversely</u>
- 23 <u>affected and threatened by the conduct of another. This Code section shall be liberally</u>
- 24 <u>construed so as to carry out the purposes thereof.</u>"

25 SECTION 2.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
