

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, so as to  
2 require the University System of Georgia and the Technical College System of Georgia to  
3 make menstrual hygiene products available at no cost to students in certain facilities or  
4 portions of facilities of institutions; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;  
5 and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, is amended in  
9 Part 2 of Article 2 of Chapter 3, relating to the University System of Georgia, by adding a  
10 new Code section to read as follows:

11 "20-3-88.

12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'menstrual hygiene products' means tampons and  
13 sanitary napkins for use in connection with the menstrual cycle.

14 (b) The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia shall make menstrual  
15 hygiene products available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of facilities or portions  
16 of facilities of institutions of the University System of Georgia that are:
