## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 8-2-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 state-wide application of minimum standard codes, adoption of more stringent requirements
- 3 by local governments, adoption of standards for which state code does not exist, and
- 4 exemptions for farm buildings and structures, so as to prohibit counties and municipalities
- 5 from proscribing the use of wood in the construction of buildings when state minimum
- 6 standard codes are otherwise met; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 7 and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Code Section 8-2-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state-wide
- application of minimum standard codes, adoption of more stringent requirements by local
- 12 governments, adoption of standards for which state code does not exist, and exemptions for
- 13 farm buildings and structures, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 14 "(c.1) Notwithstanding subsection (c) of this Code section, no county or municipality shall
- prohibit the use of wood as a construction material so long as such use conforms to all
- applicable state minimum standard codes and the Georgia State Fire Code."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
