## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to offenses against public order, so as to make it unlawful to use an emergency exit
- 3 after having shoplifted; to provide for a penalty; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 6 SECTION 1.
- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 offenses against public order, is amended by revising Code Section 16-11-40, designated as
- 9 reserved, as follows:
- 10 "16-11-40.
- 11 <u>It shall be unlawful to use an emergency exit door after having violated Code Section</u>
- 12 <u>16-8-14</u>. Any person convicted of violating this Code section shall be guilty of and
- punished as for a misdemeanor."
- SECTION 2.
- 15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
