## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 primaries and elections generally, so as to prohibit bar codes, QR codes, and other machine
- 3 codes on ballots printed by electronic ballot markers; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to primaries and
- 8 elections generally, is amended in Code Section 21-2-379.23, relating to requirements for
- 9 ballot display, role of Secretary of State, and printed paper ballot controls during recount, by
- 10 revising subsection (d) as follows:
- 11 "(d) The <u>text portion of the</u> paper ballot marked and printed by the electronic ballot marker
- 12 <u>indicating the elector's selection</u> shall constitute the official ballot and shall be used for, and
- 13 govern the result in, constitute the official vote for purposes of vote tabulation, any recount
- 14 conducted pursuant to Code Section 21-2-495, and any audit conducted pursuant to Code
- 15 Section 21-2-498. No bar codes, QR codes, or other machine coding shall be printed on
- the paper ballot marked and printed by the electronic ballot marker."

17 **SECTION 2.** 

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed. 18
