## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-5-151 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 disqualification from driving and action required after suspending, revoking, or canceling
- 3 license or nonresident privileges, so as to require disqualification to operate a commercial
- 4 motor vehicle upon receipt of notification from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety
- 5 Administration of a positive drug test, an adulterated or substituted drug test, or a report of
- 6 a refusal to submit to such test; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 7 for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 Code Section 40-5-151 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 11 disqualification from driving and action required after suspending, revoking, or canceling
- 12 license or nonresident privileges, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 13 "(i.1) Any person is disqualified from operating a commercial motor vehicle upon receipt
- of notification by the department from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in
- accordance with 49 C.F.R. Parts 382, 383, and 384. Such person shall be reinstated upon
