## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 12, 2020, as Albany-Dougherty County Day at the state capitol, and  
2 commending the Albany Area Chamber of Commerce; and for other purposes.

4 establishing Georgia as the No. 1 state in which to do business; and
