## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce and its Leadership Clayton Class  
2 of 2024 and recognizing February 8, 2024, as Leadership Clayton Day at the state capitol;

5 and it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding leadership and diligence  
6 demonstrated by the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce as it influences growth and  
7 perpetuates the thriving of this superlative county be recognized; and

8 WHEREAS, the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce, founded in 1953, is a  
9 member-based nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting business growth and enhancing  
10 the quality of life through economic prosperity; and

13 helping to strengthen our community; and

14 WHEREAS, the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce continues to provide leadership and  
15 educational opportunities with its Leadership Clayton program, established in 1972, which

16 has engaged more than 925 emerging and existing leaders in a ten-month program that  
17 broadens their knowledge of community issues, sharpens their leadership skills, and  
18 challenges themselves and others to seek solutions to those issues affecting our communities;

20 WHEREAS, Leadership Clayton class members are invited to participate each year in the  
21 chamber day at the state capitol to meet with our state leaders during the legislative session,  
22 discuss legislative priorities that are important to their business and the county, and see our  
23 state government in action.

25 the members of this body commend the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce on its
