A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the lives of Kristi Jayne, Karolyn "Karri" Marie, and Tabbatha Rene' Lawhorne
2 and dedicating an intersection in their memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Kristi Jayne, Karolyn "Karri" Marie, and Tabbatha Rene' Lawhorne passed
4 away in a tragic car accident on May 17, 1998; and

5 WHEREAS, Kristi Jayne Lawhorne was born on May 16, 1980, and was a cheerleader,
6 cross-country runner, and a budding actress; and

7 WHEREAS, Kristi Jayne had a great love for Jesus and after her passing it was discovered
8 that she had a list of over 100 people for whom she prayed daily; and

9 WHEREAS, Tabbatha Rene' Lawhorne was born in June 18, 1982, and was a standout soccer
10 and softball player; and

11 WHEREAS, Tabbatha was a compassionate and generous soul, who went out of her way to
12 help others in their time of need; and

13 WHEREAS, Karolyn "Karri" Marie Lawhorne was born on December 18, 1983, and was
14 beautiful both inside and out; and

15 WHEREAS, Karri loved her family and friends fiercely and was known as the life of the
16 party as a talented singer, star athlete, and an amazing artist; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that these remarkable and distinguished
18 Georgians be recognized appropriately by dedicating an intersection in their memory.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
20 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 400 and Setting Down
21 Circle in Forsyth County is dedicated as the Lawhorne Memorial Intersection.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
23 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Lawhorne Memorial
24 Intersection.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
27 Lawhorne family and to the Department of Transportation.
