- 6 Georgia Tech in 1957 and 1958, respectively, and a Ph.D. in electrical engineering from

- 8 WHEREAS, Dr. Ecker played football under Coach Bobby Dodd, securing victories for the
- 9 Yellow Jackets in the Cotton, Sugar, and Gator Bowls and achieving the honors of
- 10 second-team All-American and academic All-American; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he spent ten years with the Georgia Tech Research Institute as Director of the
- 12 Applied Engineering Laboratory, building up sponsored research in its Radar Division,
- 13 Countermeasures Division, Communications Division, and Biomedical Electronic Division;

- 15 WHEREAS, Dr. Ecker retired from a successful career as Executive Vice President of
- 16 Scientific Atlanta where his legacy of technical innovation included his leadership in
- developing a digital television cable network and other pioneering efforts in digital television
