13 with Teaching Careers and Academic Readiness), which led him to the field of education;

15 WHEREAS, he received his undergraduate degree in accounting from Fort Valley State
16 University and recently attended Georgia College and State University, where he completed
17 a Master of Education in educational leadership; and

18 WHEREAS, he began his career with Comcast as a top executive sales agent and was
19 promoted to the Xfinity marketing team, and then he worked for Google; and

20 WHEREAS, in addition to being Teacher of the Year, Nagi Eltayeb serves as a discipline
21 leader and math department chair; and

22 WHEREAS, in recognition of such remarkable contributions to the education and welfare
23 of Georgia's students, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to honor the
24 extraordinary accomplishments and academic achievements of this outstanding educator.
