A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Reducing Georgia's Dependence on BRICS States;
- 2 and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, "BRICS" is an intergovernmental organization comprising Brazil, Russia, India,
- 4 China, South Africa, Egypt, Ethiopia, Iran, and the United Arab Emirates; and
- 5 WHEREAS, combined, the BRICS members encompass approximately 30 percent of the
- 6 world's land surface and 45 percent of the global population; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the five initial member states are members of the G20, with a combined
- 8 nominal GDP of \$28 trillion and a total GDP of roughly \$57 trillion; and
- 9 WHEREAS, arguably, BRICS states are the primary geopolitical rival to the G7 bloc of
- 10 leading advanced economics; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the United States is a member of the G7 bloc; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in 2021, Georgia imports totaled \$123.74 billion with two of the state's top
- 13 import markets being BRICS member states; and

14 WHEREAS, a study committee is needed to determine what efforts may be made within

- 15 Georgia to depend less on BRICS states so as to increase competition and, in turn, strengthen
- 16 the country's global financial positioning.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 18 (1) Creation of House study committee. There is created the House Study Committee
- on Reducing Georgia's Dependence on BRICS States.
- 20 (2) Members and officers.
- 21 (A) The committee shall be composed of six members of the House of Representatives
- as follows:
- (i) One member from the House Committee on Banks and Banking;
- 24 (ii) One member from the House Committee on Agriculture and Consumer Affairs;
- 25 (iii) One member from the House Committee on Economic Development and
- Tourism;
- 27 (iv) One member from the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment;
- (v) One member from the House Committee on Small Business Development; and
- 29 (vi) One member from the House Committee on State Properties.
- 30 (B) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate one such member of
- the committee as chairperson of the committee.
- 32 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 35 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

39 (5) Allowances and funding. The legislative members of the committee shall receive

- 40 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 41 Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any
- 42 member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.
- Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.
- 45 (6) **Report.**
- 46 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- of this paragraph.
- 53 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- 57 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 59 thereof.
- 60 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2024.
