## A RESOLUTION

1 Supporting economic, cultural, security, and educational cooperation with Hungary and  
2 recognizing February 8, 2020, as Hungary Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, only 30 years ago, Hungary emerged from the dark period of Communism and  
4 domination by the Soviet Union; and

5 WHEREAS, today Hungary, as well as most nations of the former Soviet Bloc, particularly  
6 the countries of Central and Eastern Europe, enjoy a democratic way of life and are faithful  
7 allies of the United States and proud members of NATO and the European Union; and

8 WHEREAS, there is a bond of friendship between the citizens of Georgia and Hungary, and  
9 the people of Georgia welcome opportunities to grow our already deep relationship at all  
10 levels; and

11 WHEREAS, Hungary Day at the state capitol will cement the already close and friendly  
12 connections between the State of Georgia and Hungary and further promote business,  
13 cultural, educational, security, and scientific ties between our state and Hungary.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
15 the members of this body support economic, cultural, security, and educational cooperation  
16 with Hungary and recognize February 8, 2020, as Hungary Day at the state capitol.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
18 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
19 public and the press.
