- WHEREAS, in 1990, Mayor Johnson was recognized as Teacher of the Year, which was the 16 17 first of many awards she received over the years. Her most recent accolade was being named
- 18 2019 Citizen of the Year by the Gwinnett Chamber of Commerce; and
- WHEREAS, Mayor Johnson has always displayed an unwavering commitment to public 19
- 20 service and her community. She is an active member and deacon of the First Baptist Church
- of Lawrenceville, and she currently volunteers at local schools, the Lawrenceville Co-Op, 21
