A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating and commending Eloise Scott Archibald for receiving the 2020 Yellow Rose
2 Nikki T. Randall Servant Leader Award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in 1999, Representative Nikki T. Randall became the first African American
4 woman elected to the General Assembly from middle Georgia and, over her 17 years of
5 service as a legislator, she held numerous leadership positions, including chair of the Georgia
6 Legislative Women's Caucus; and

7 WHEREAS, every year during Women's History Month, the Georgia Legislative Women's
8 Caucus recognizes outstanding women in Georgia who exemplify the leadership and
9 inspiration embodied by Representative Randall; and

10 WHEREAS, Eloise Scott Archibald, the 2020 recipient of the Servant Leader Award, has
11 selflessly dedicated herself to community service for decades, serving with the Clayton
12 County NAACP as its Freedom Fund chair, membership chair, and secretary; as advisor to
13 the Clayton County Youth Council; and as secretary with the Clayton County Martin Luther
14 King Jr. Parade Committee; and

15 WHEREAS, Eloise currently serves as district matron of the Stockbridge #17 Order of the
16 Eastern Star under the Smooth Ashlar Grand Chapter Order of the Eastern Star; under her
17 leadership, the group has supported the Clayton County Association Against Family
18 Violence Inc.; and

19 WHEREAS, she earned her associate's degree in accounting from Augusta Technical College
20 and had a fulfilling career with Munich American Reassurance Company, where she retired
21 as a senior administrative accounting analyst after 40 years of dedicated service; and

22 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Eloise is an active member of the Fountain
23 of Faith Baptist Church in Riverdale, Georgia; her love of Jesus fuels her devotion and
24 commitment to helping those less fortunate; and

25 WHEREAS, she has established a glowing reputation of renown throughout the State of
26 Georgia for her deep personal commitment to the welfare of its citizens; and

27 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
28 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
30 the members of this body congratulate and commend Eloise Scott Archibald for receiving
31 the 2020 Yellow Rose Nikki T. Randall Servant Leader Award and extend best wishes for
