A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Mr. Maceo A. Brown and dedicating an intersection in his memory; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Maceo A. Brown was born in Atlanta, Georgia, and attended Henry McNeil
4 Turner High School; and

5 WHEREAS, he became a certified electrician in 1974 and began his own business, Maceo A.
6 Brown Electrical Contractors, which provides residential and commercial electrical services;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Brown established System 5 Electronics, which provides residential and
9 commercial alarm system installation and monitoring; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2007, he founded MACEO's Kids, Inc., (Mentoring Aspiring CEO's), to
11 bring intelligent, compassionate, and dedicated members of the business community together
12 in pursuit of providing local youth with the opportunities and tools to grow as successful
13 members of society; and

14 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
15 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
17 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 139 and Martin Luther
18 King, Jr., Drive Southwest in Fulton County is dedicated as the Maceo A. Brown Memorial
19 Intersection.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
21 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Maceo A. Brown Memorial
22 Intersection.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
24 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
25 family of Mr. Maceo A. Brown and to the Department of Transportation.
