A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing February as American Heart Month at the state capitol; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia celebrates the extraordinary progress in heart health that
- 3 has been made in recent years and recognizes that more needs to be done in Georgia to
- 4 safeguard heart health for generations to come; and
- 5 WHEREAS, approximately 92 million Americans are affected by major cardiovascular
- 6 disease; and
- 7 WHEREAS, heart disease is the number one killer of Americans and Georgians; and
- 8 WHEREAS, each year, there are more than 350,000 out-of-hospital sudden cardiac arrests
- 9 in the United States and approximately 10,000 in Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the survival rate for out-of-hospital sudden cardiac arrest averages 10 percent
- 11 annually; and
- 12 WHEREAS, 80 percent of all sudden cardiac arrest victims are shown to have underlying
- 13 heart disease; and
- 14 WHEREAS, survival from sudden cardiac arrest most often depends upon immediate
- 15 bystander-initiated cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and an early shock from an
- 16 automatic external defibrillator (AED); and
- 17 WHEREAS, fewer than 40 percent of sudden cardiac arrest victims outside of a hospital
- 18 receive bystander-initiated CPR, and fewer than 2 percent of victims receive a shock from
- 19 bystander-initiated AED; and

20 WHEREAS, keeping Georgians healthy and promoting awareness of health issues, including

- 21 heart disease, is an important responsibility and depends on the actions of many
- 22 organizations and groups in our community; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the American Heart Month Awareness campaign has been endorsed and
- 24 sponsored by national groups such as the American Heart Association, the American Red
- 25 Cross, the National Institutes of Health, and the Centers for Disease Control and Injury
- 26 Prevention and is observed by many health care providers and health education advocacy
- 27 groups; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Georgians need to take action to make heart health a priority for themselves and
- 29 their families, become aware of their risk for heart disease, and take action to provide better
- 30 outcomes in their heart health.
- 31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 32 the members of this body recognize February as American Heart Month at the state capitol.
- 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 34 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 35 public and the press.
