A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging Congress to eliminate the five-month waiting period for disability insurance benefits
- 2 for individuals living with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS); and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS) is commonly known as Lou Gehrig's
- 4 disease; and
- 5 WHEREAS, ALS is a progressive and fatal neuromuscular disease; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the average time to diagnosis is more than 12 months; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the majority of ALS patients die within two to five years of receiving a
- 8 diagnosis; and
- 9 WHEREAS, approximately 6,000 people in the United States are diagnosed with ALS each
- 10 year; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the incidence of ALS is two per 100,000 people, and it is estimated that more
- 12 than 20,000 Americans may be living with ALS at any given time; and
- 13 WHEREAS, ALS occurs through the world with no racial, ethnic, or socioeconomic
- boundaries and can affect anyone; and
- 15 WHEREAS, military veterans are approximately twice as likely to develop ALS; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the onset of ALS often involves muscle weakness or stiffness as early
- 17 symptoms. Progression of weakness, wasting, and paralysis of the muscles of the limbs and
- 18 trunk, as well as those that control vital functions such as speech, swallowing, and later
- 19 breathing, generally follows; and

20 WHEREAS, there can be significant costs for medical care, equipment, and home health

- 21 caregiving later in the disease; and
- 22 WHEREAS, under current law, individuals must wait five months after becoming disabled
- 23 before their Social Security Disability Insurance benefit payments can begin; and
- 24 WHEREAS, last year, Congress considered legislation that would eliminate the five-month
- 25 waiting period for disability insurance benefits for individuals with ALS, but it unfortunately
- 26 did not become law; and
- 27 WHEREAS, this body recognizes that persons living with ALS cannot wait for benefits.
- 28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 29 this body urges Congress to eliminate the five-month waiting period for disability insurance
- 30 benefits for individuals living with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS).
- 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 32 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 33 President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of
- Representatives, and to each member of the Congressional delegation from this state.
