## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending SkillsUSA for its outstanding contributions; and for other  
2 purposes.

4 of our young adults and citizens; and many academic programs, which are embraced by the  
5 youth, communities, and citizens of our state, are continually utilized to develop these skills;

8 education programs that provide quality educational experiences for students in leadership,  
9 teamwork, citizenship, and character development; and

19 workers and responsible citizens, and it is abundantly fitting and proper that these programs  
20 be recognized.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
22 the members of this body commend SkillsUSA and recognize its valuable contributions to  
23 the community, the State of Georgia, and the nation.
