11 professional volunteer, fearless leader, and perpetual truth teller; and

13 Debbie dedicated innumerable hours of her time and energy to the well-being of her
14 community and spent much of her life in service of others; and

15 WHEREAS, as First Lady of Peachtree Corners, Georgia, she served as a founding board
16 member of the Peachtree Corners Festival and the Glow in the Corners Holiday Festival as
17 well as part of the United Peachtree Corners Civic Association Board, the Gwinnett Clean
18 and Beautiful Board, the City Arts Council, and the City Green Committee; and

19 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern
20 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to
21 her family and friends were admired by others; and

23 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example she made of her life,
