A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the Province of Sindh's status as a sister state with Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Sindh was the site of one of the cradle of civilizations, the Bronze Age Indus
- 3 Valley civilization, which flourished from about 3000 BCE. Sindh is home to two
- 4 UNESCO-designated World Heritage Sites: the Makli Necropolis and Mohenjo-daro; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the economy of Sindh is the second-largest in Pakistan; its provincial capital
- 6 of Karachi is the most populous city in the country as well as its main financial hub; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Sindh is home to a large portion of Pakistan's industrial sector and contains two
- 8 of the country's busiest commercial seaports: Port Qasim and the Port of Karachi. The
- 9 remainder of Sindh consists of an agriculture-based economy and produces fruits, consumer
- 10 items, and vegetables for other parts of the country, similar to the State of Georgia; and
- WHEREAS, much of Sindh's economy is influenced by the economy of Karachi, the largest
- 12 city and economic capital of the country. Historically, Sindh's contribution to Pakistan's
- 13 GDP has been between 30 percent to 32.7 percent; and

14 WHEREAS the Province of Sindh is endowed with coastal access and is a major center of

- 15 economic activity in Pakistan with a highly diversified economy ranging from heavy industry
- and finance centered in and around Karachi to a substantial agricultural base along the Indus.
- 17 Manufacturing includes machine products, cement, plastics, and various other goods; and
- 18 WHEREAS, agriculture plays an important role in Sindh with cotton, rice, wheat, sugar cane,
- bananas, and mangoes as the most important crops. The largest and finer quality of rice is
- 20 produced in the Larkano district; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Sindh is the richest province in natural resources of gas, petrol, and coal; and
- WHEREAS, Georgia is home to the Honorable Farooq Mughal, the first Pakistan-American
- and Sindhi-American elected to the Georgia House of Representatives; and
- 24 WHEREAS, a sister-state relationship between the State of Georgia and the Province of
- 25 Sindh would promote mutual trade and commerce and increase the potential for educational,
- 26 environmental, and cultural relations between the Province of Sindh and the State of Georgia;
- 27 and
- 28 WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Georgia, on behalf of the people of Georgia,
- 29 extends to the people of the Province of Sindh an invitation to join with Georgia in a
- 30 sister-state relationship until December 31, 2026, in order to encourage and facilitate
- 31 mutually beneficial economic, educational, environmental, and cultural exchanges and to
- 32 lead to a more indelible and lasting relationship between Georgians and the people of the
- 33 Province of Sindh.

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that

- any sister state agreement developed will identify objectives, areas of mutual interest, a list
- 36 of potential activities, and an initial list of public and private partners that will help to
- 37 advance the purposes of the sister state agreement, including one or more entities that will
- 38 serve as facilitators and general points of contact.
- 39 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 40 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the
- 41 Governor of Georgia, State Representative Farooq Mughal, the Governor of Sindh, the
- 42 Legislature of Sindh, and the representatives from Georgia in the United States Congress.
