- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Johnny B. Corbett on March 1, 2019; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Johnny B. Corbett was born on May 4, 1930, in Lake Park, Georgia; and
- 5 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Johnny was an active member of Saint Luke
6 Free Will Baptist Church; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Johnny held a seat as a councilman from 1995 until 2005 and as Mayor Pro
8 Tem in 2002 in Lake Park, Georgia, and retired from Lowndes County Public Works after
9 more than 25 years of service; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
11 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
12 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Johnny was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable
14 reputation for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and by the example he made of
15 his life, he made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 16 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Johnny will long be remembered for his
17 love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who had the great
18 fortune of knowing him.
