- 13 Way of Hall County, president of the Gainesville Northeast Georgia Bar Association,
- 14 president of the Kiwanis Club of Gainesville, and board member of Chattahoochee Bank of
- 15 Georgia; after 40 years of practicing law, Billy entered a new chapter of his life when he was
- 16 appointed commissioner of the Georgia Real Estate and Appraisers Board; and
- 17 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Billy was an active, lifelong member of
- 18 Gainesville First United Methodist Church; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he was united in love and marriage to his wife, Mary Kelly Rogers, and was
- 20 blessed with three remarkable children, Lee, Robert, and Meg; and five wonderful
