- 12 helping to advocate for the profession, its members, and the individuals they serve; and

- 14 exchange of professional information and ideas, including continuing education, to its
- 15 member speech-language pathologists in this state; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Georgia Speech-Language-Hearing Association's members are licensed
- 17 professionals, with many holding advanced degrees from accredited universities with
- 18 specialized training programs, such as the education of or the prevention, identification,
- 19 assessment, and treatment of hearing and communication disorders; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Georgia Speech-Language-Hearing Association members provide services in
- 21 various settings, including public schools, private practice, hospitals, clinics, physicians'
- 22 offices, universities, and pre-k through 12 schools, as well as government and military
