A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on Workforce Housing; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, there is a proven need for workforce housing in the State of Georgia; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the mandatory state building codes and local amendments to such codes provide
- 4 clear direction to local officials, builders, and the general public on the methods and
- 5 materials required for the construction of safe and reliable structures; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the requirements of residential design mandates exist outside the realm of
- 7 building integrity and have no connection to the safety and welfare of the citizens of Georgia;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, such requirements infringe on an individual's private property rights and a
- 10 consumer's choice of building products and materials, many of which are manufactured in
- 11 Georgia; and
- 12 WHEREAS, such requirements add an unnecessary burden of higher costs to the individual
- 13 homeowner, preventing thousands of Georgians from owning a new home; and
- 14 WHEREAS, for the purposes of protecting private property rights, allowing for consumer
- 15 choice, and encouraging the development of affordable housing options, it would be
- beneficial to review the existing regulation and current practices relating to locally adopted
- 17 residential design mandates.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 19 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on Workforce Housing.
- 21 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of five members of the
- House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of

23 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson 24

- 25 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- 26 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- 27 legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 28 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 29 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 30 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- 31 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

32 (5) Allowances and funding.

- 33 (A) Members of the committee who are members of the General Assembly shall
- 34 receive the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of
- 35 Georgia Annotated.
- (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member 36
- 37 of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- 38 necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- 39 appropriated to the House of Representatives.

(6) Report.

- 41 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- 42 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- 43 same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- 44 subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 45 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- 46 proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- 47 of this paragraph.
- 48 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee. 49
- A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with 50
- 51 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the 52
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu 53
- 54 thereof.
- (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2019. 55
