- 14 WHEREAS, in 1993, he was named principal of Thomas County Central High School,
- 15 loyally serving thousands of children from Thomas County until his retirement in 2008; and
- 16 WHEREAS, when called upon by the school district in a time of need, he returned to the
- 17 school system in 2011 to serve Thomas County Central High School as Dean of Students and
- 18 Principal Emeritus; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he has led students, teachers, and the community at large with his uncanny
- 20 wisdom, his powerful sincerity, and his gracious good humor; and
