## A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating the EC Bullets-Gravley 14U Fast-pitch Softball Team; and for other  
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the EC Bullets-Gravley 14U Fast-pitch Softball Team competed in and won  
4 back to back Championship Titles in October 2022 to kick-off their Fall Season, maintaining  
5 a proud tradition of excellence and hard work under the organizational guidance of EC  
6 Bullets Founder Coach Greg Schnute; and

7 WHEREAS, this superlative team has completed another triumphant season of fast-pitch  
8 softball competition by posting an outstanding record of 11 wins and only five losses,  
9 defining themselves as a team of hardworking and dedicated fast-pitch softball  
10 student-athletes; and

11 WHEREAS, the Bullets began their fall season on October 22, 2022, at Burnt Hickory Park  
12 in Dallas, Georgia, in the PGF (Premier Girls Fast-pitch) Queen of Diamond Tournament.  
13 the Bullets entered bracket play as the fifth overall seed and went undefeated in the  
14 semi-finals headed into the championship game against the Georgia Thunderbolts from  
15 Fayetteville, Georgia. The Bullets won the championship game 5-1, posting their first  
16 championship win in 2022; and

17 WHEREAS, on October 29, 2022, the Bullets entered the USSSA Children's Healthcare  
18 Tournament in Covington, Georgia, at Turner Lake Field. The Bullets were undefeated in  
19 pool play and entered bracket play as the second overall seed. The Bullets continued their  
20 winning streak by defeating North Georgia Freedom 3-1 and were victorious over Buford  
21 Fast-pitch 3-1 in the semi-finals to face All Sports Fusion from Bremen, Georgia, in the  
22 Championship Game. The Bullets defeated All Sports Fusion 4-2 to claim the USSSA  
23 Championship for consecutive championship victories in October 2022; and

24 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding  
25 athletic ability, dedication, hard work, and unity of purpose and spirit of each member of the  
26 team; its superb offensive and defensive talents; and the astute direction of Head Coach
