A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Jonathan Mangrum on being selected as a David L. Boren
2 Scholar; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Boren Scholarships, an initiative of the National Security Education Program,
4 provide unique funding opportunities for United States undergraduate students to study less
5 commonly taught languages in world regions critical to United States interests; and

6 WHEREAS, Jonathan Mangrum, a senior political science major from Augusta, Georgia, is
7 the first student from Georgia College & State University to receive the prestigious David
8 L. Boren Scholarship; and

9 WHEREAS, in August of 2018, Jonathan travelled to Lucknow, India, to complete a
10 semester studying the Urdu language, one of the official languages of India and the official
11 language of Pakistan, and he is continuing to develop his language proficiency in India
12 before graduation from Georgia College in 2019; and

13 WHEREAS, Jonathan has been active in campus activities at Georgia College, including
14 serving as a senator and chief justice in the Student Government Association, a member of
15 the mock trial team, an officer of the Model United Nations Club, and a member of the
16 Executive Committee for the Eta Sigma Alpha Honor Society; and

17 WHEREAS, in 2017, Jonathan was recognized by Campus Compact as a Newman Civic
18 Fellow for his work as a member of the American Democracy Project on the Georgia College
19 campus, which enabled him to spend a semester studying at George Mason University while
20 participating in an internship in Washington, D.C.; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
22 remarkable young Georgian be appropriately recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body recognize and commend Jonathan Mangrum for his countless
25 accomplishments and express their most sincere best wishes for future success.
