A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Nadia Theodore, Consul General of Canada in Atlanta, United
2 States; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the government of Canada has a consular presence in the State of Georgia that
4 serves and protects Canadian citizens across the six states of Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi,
5 North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee; and

6 WHEREAS, the Consulate General of Canada in Atlanta also promotes business
7 development, investment, tourism, culture, and information exchange between Canada and
8 the southeastern states of Alabama, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina,
9 and Tennessee; and

10 WHEREAS, Nadia Theodore was appointed Consul General of Canada in Atlanta in
11 September of 2017 due to her long and consistent record of service to international relations,
12 and she is dedicated and committed to fostering Canada's relations with Georgia and the
13 United States; and

14 WHEREAS, Consul General Theodore is steadfastly committed to maintaining mutual
15 respect and understanding between cultures which enhances stability and promotes prosperity
16 and diplomacy throughout the world, making it abundantly fitting and proper that her
17 valuable contributions be appropriately recognized.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize the special friendship between Georgia and Canada and
20 express appreciation to the Consul General of Canada in Atlanta, Nadia Theodore, for her
21 efforts to promote economic, educational, and cultural exchanges between the United States
22 and Canada.
