## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and supporting the commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion throughout
- 2 the great State of Georgia; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia's economic and social strength derives from the diversity
- 4 of its population and from its commitment to fair treatment and equitable services for all
- 5 residents; and
- 6 WHEREAS, inequality has a ripple effect on entire communities, particularly those that have
- 7 been disproportionately impacted by structural, social, and institutional inequities and
- 8 injustices; and
- 9 WHEREAS Georgia's future growth and economic prosperity depends on the diversity,
- 10 equity, and inclusiveness of its citizens, communities, businesses, and social and economic
- 11 interests; and
- 12 WHEREAS, diversity is integral to a strong economy and inclusive growth; and a diverse
- and inclusive economy is an economy that does not discriminate and treats all its groups on
- an equal footing; and equal opportunities with respect to education and jobs can generate a
- 15 wide range of economic benefits; and

16 WHEREAS, a diverse workforce facilitates innovation and creativity; and over 85 percent

- 17 of successful businesses interviewed in a Forbes research study said that a diverse workforce
- 18 was the key to innovation and creativity; and
- 19 WHEREAS, economic studies show there will be no racial or ethnic majority in the United
- 20 States by 2050; and having a diverse workplace is going to be key for companies that want
- 21 to grow, including having women, people of color, and LGBT employment representatives
- 22 in boardrooms; and
- 23 WHEREAS, this body strongly encourages and supports the promotion of fairness and
- 24 equality and to combat unlawful discrimination and harassment in the workplace and for all
- 25 residents.

- 27 the members of this body recognize and support this state's commitment to diversity, equity,
