A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the House Study Committee on School Nutrition Program Funding; and for other
- 2 purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the current funding of school nutrition programs in Georgia needs occasional
- 4 review by the General Assembly; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the school nutrition program is funded by federal, state, and local sources.
- 6 Ensuring a healthy, nutritious, and effective nutrition program is important for a positive
- 7 educational environment; and
- 8 WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to the General Assembly, students, and the workers in
- 9 local school nutrition programs to study this vital program state wide; and
- 10 WHEREAS, it would be helpful to study state and federal funding of school nutrition
- programs before the recession of 2007 to 2009, during said recession, and since the end of
- 12 said recession; and
- WHEREAS, the issues of funding levels, historical trends, participation in programs, local
- 14 funding, and employee pay each need review; and
- 15 WHEREAS, it would also be helpful to study the reasons for not including school nutrition
- 16 program workers in state benefit plans and to investigate alternate sources of school nutrition
- 17 program funding.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:
- 19 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee
- on the School Nutrition Program Funding.
- 21 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of six members of the
- House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of

23 Representatives. The Speaker shall designate a member of the committee as chairperson of the committee.

- 25 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,
- 26 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 28 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee
- 29 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or
- 30 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and
- accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

32 (5) Allowances and funding.

- 33 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 35 (B) The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any member
- of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. Funds
- 37 necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds
- appropriated to the House of Representatives.

39 (6) **Report.**

- 40 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- 41 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)
- of this paragraph.
- 47 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- 49 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with
- the Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- 51 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the
- House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu
- 53 thereof.
- 54 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2019.
