A RESOLUTION

1 Expressing support for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta, Georgia, for bicycle

2 traffic; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, there is a need for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta for bicycle traffic,

4 including bicycle connectivity between major cities such as Atlanta, Decatur, Clarkston, and

5 Stone Mountain, by the PATH Foundation; and

6 WHEREAS, with the diversity of businesses and educational opportunities, bicyclists

7 commute to and from work, school, and college, as well as bike to run errands, visit parks

8 and recreation centers, and many more activities; and

9 WHEREAS, although most people assume that the Stone Mountain PATH trail was

10 completed long ago, the trail over and approaching I-285 has not been completed, making

11 these areas particularly dangerous for both bicyclists and motorists.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that

13 the members of this body express support for an eastern corridor in metropolitan Atlanta,

14 Georgia, for bicycle traffic.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized

16 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the public and the press.
