A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the Georgia Association of Physicians of Indian Heritage (GAPI) for its impact
- 2 on the medical profession, the Indian Diaspora, and its local communities; and for other
- 3 purposes.
- 4 WHEREAS, GAPI was established in 1987 by Indian physicians practicing in the State of
- 5 Georgia as a forum for sharing information of common interest; and
- 6 WHEREAS, GAPI promotes scientific, educational, civic, and professional activities and
- 7 acts as a liaison between various professional organizations in the United States and India;
- 8 and
- 9 WHEREAS, GAPI has about 700 members and 214 life members and is continually
- 10 growing; and
- WHEREAS, GAPI's mission includes promoting close relationships and communication
- 12 among its members; enhancing the standard of practice in the arts and science of medicine
- 13 through educational, social, and scientific activities; assisting its members in establishing
- 14 their practices in the State of Georgia; protecting the professional interests of its members;
- 15 maintaining liaison and communication with other Indian associations, medical societies, and

16 cultural organizations; and assisting members in maintaining close liaison with local,

- 17 national, and international medical societies and organizations in North America and abroad,
- 18 including those in India; and
- 19 WHEREAS, GAPI has an annual meeting as well as regional meetings in Atlanta, Augusta,
- 20 Savannah, and Warner Robins; and
- 21 WHEREAS, GAPI operates a free clinic in Global Mall in Norcross, providing dental
- 22 consultation, minimal cost for lab work, discounted rates for medications and flu shots, and
- 23 referrals to specialists at a discounted fee on the first and third Saturdays of the month; and
- 24 WHEREAS, GAPI provides scholarships through the GAPI Educational Awards and
- 25 Humanitarian Awards to students of Indian origin residing and attending local colleges in the
- 26 State of Georgia, from undergraduate or graduate programs, and to community leaders.
- 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 28 the members of this body recognize the Georgia Association of Physicians of Indian Heritage
- 29 for its positive impact on the medical community, Indian diaspora, and Georgia.
- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the
