1 Commending Morris "Mo" Clyde Lewis III; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, born on October 21, 1969, Morris "Mo" Clyde Lewis III is a former football
3 linebacker who played in the National Football League (NFL) for 13 seasons with the New
4 York Jets; and

5 WHEREAS, Lewis began his career as a star player at the University of Georgia, where he
6 sported the number 57, a number he would carry into his professional career; and

7 WHEREAS, Lewis played 200 games as a Jet, the third longest tenure in franchise history,
8 and was one of the most loved team players and captains of his time; and

9 WHEREAS, he was a three-time Pro Bowler, the New York Jets defensive captain from
10 1997–2003, and was named to the NFL All-Pro team after the 1998 season; and

11 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the phenomenal career and
12 accomplishments of this extraordinary Georgian be appropriately recognized.
