- 8 WHEREAS, a member of the State Bar of Georgia, he practiced law with his long-term
- 9 business partner Bill Erwin in Camilla, Georgia, and he served as a judge for the Municipal
- 10 Court of Camilla, as president of the Mitchell County Bar Association, and as a member of
- 11 the Mitchell County Law Library Board of Trustees and the Georgia Institute of Continuing
- 12 Legal Education Board of Trustees; and
- 13 WHEREAS, an active member of his community, Representative Powell held various
- 14 executive roles within the Camilla Chamber of Commerce, received the Citizen of the Year
- 15 award in 2001 and the Lifetime Achievement Award in 2008, and served as a faithful
- 16 member of the Camilla Rotary Club; and
- 17 WHEREAS, a dedicated and venerable public servant, Representative Powell served as
- mayor of Camilla from 1996–2007; he was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives
- in 2008, where he represented House District 171 until his passing; and

- 21 served as chairperson of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Public Safety, the Ways and
- 22 Means Committee, and the Rules Committee; and
