A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Heather Williamson; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Heather Williamson is the state recipient of the Technical College System of
3 Georgia's (TCSG) 2019 Georgia Occupational Award of Leadership (GOAL), which is the
4 first program of its type in the nation to honor outstanding technical college students; and

5 WHEREAS, GOAL brings together Georgia's business, government, and industry leaders
6 with the state's technical colleges to celebrate technical education's vital impact on Georgia's
7 workforce, prosperity, and future; and

8 WHEREAS, for 48 years, the GOAL program has served as an excellent example of a true
9 partnership among business, industry, and higher education; and

10 WHEREAS, Heather Williamson was selected from among 22 TCSG college GOAL winners
11 who have demonstrated excellent academic and leadership abilities at their respective
12 technical colleges; and

13 WHEREAS, Heather Williamson, an early childhood care and education student from
14 Central Georgia Technical College, enrolled to receive the very best training necessary to
15 acquire the knowledge and skills that will afford her a secure future in her chosen profession;

17 WHEREAS, Heather Williamson will serve as an ambassador for technical education in
18 Georgia, representing over 140,000 TCSG students who benefit from technical education
19 programs at colleges throughout the state; and

20 WHEREAS, in pursuing her education, Heather Williamson brought honor to herself, her
21 family, Central Georgia Technical College, and the entire Technical College System of
22 Georgia, which she represents as Georgia's outstanding technical college student for 2019.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
24 the members of this body recognize and commend Heather Williamson for her outstanding
25 achievements and efforts to promote technical education in Georgia.
