A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 40-6-391 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	driving under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or other intoxicating substances, penalties,
3	publication of notice of conviction for persons convicted for a second time, and endangering
4	a child, so as to change the age of a child constituting child endangerment; to provide
5	penalties for certain violations; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 Code Section 40-6-391 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to driving under 9 the influence of alcohol, drugs, or other intoxicating substances, penalties, publication of 10 notice of conviction for persons convicted for a second time, and endangering a child, is 11 amended by revising subsection (1) as follows:

12 "(1)(1) A person who violates this Code section while transporting in a motor vehicle a 13 child under the age of 14 <u>16</u> years is guilty of the separate offense of endangering a child 14 by driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs. The offense of endangering a child 15 by driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall not be merged with the offense 16 of driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs for the purposes of prosecution and 17 sentencing.

(2) An offender who is convicted of a violation of this subsection shall be punished in accordance with the provisions of subsection (d) of Code Section 16-12-1, relating to the offense of contributing to the delinquency, unruliness, or deprivation of a child.

(3) An offender who is convicted of a violation of this subsection which resulted in
serious injury to the child passenger shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by
incarceration for not more than 15 years. An offender who is convicted of a violation of
this subsection which resulted in death of the child passenger shall be guilty of a felony
and shall be punished by incarceration for not more than 25 years.

- 26 (4) If any offender who is convicted of a violation of this subsection is the parent or
- 27 guardian of the child passenger, the prosecuting attorney shall notify the department of
- 28 <u>family and children services of the county of such person's residence.</u>"

29 **SECTION 2.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
