A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 10 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Georgia Board of Health Care Workforce, so as to provide for student loan repayment for
- 3 certain nursing faculty; to provide for definitions; to authorize the board to approve
- 4 applications; to provide for eligibility requirements; to provide for continued eligibility
- 5 requirements; to provide for student loan repayment agreements and conditions; to provide
- 6 for rules and regulations; to provide for an appropriations contingency; to provide for related
- 7 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

- 9 SECTION 1.
- 10 Chapter 10 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia
- 11 Board of Health Care Workforce, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 "49-10-6.
- 14 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Eligible applicant' means a person who:
- 16 (A) Is a legal resident of the State of Georgia as established by rules and regulations
- of the board;

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(B) Is a registered professional nurse duly licensed and authorized to practice in this

- 19 <u>state under Article 1 of Chapter 26 of Title 43;</u>
- 20 (C) Holds a master's or doctoral degree in nursing; and
- 21 (D) Is currently employed and has been employed for at least one year as a faculty
- 22 member of a nursing program at a postsecondary institution in this state in a position
- 23 <u>that requires an advanced degree in professional nursing.</u>
- 24 (2) 'Recipient' means an eligible applicant who applied for and was approved by the
- 25 <u>board for student loan repayment under this Code section.</u>
- 26 (3) 'Student loan' means debt incurred by an eligible applicant that is:
- 27 (A) Evidenced by a promissory note which required the funds received to be used to
- pay for the cost of attendance for the undergraduate, graduate, or professional education
- 29 <u>of the eligible applicant;</u>
- 30 (B) Not in default at the time of application for repayment under this Code section; and
- 31 (C) Not subject to an existing service obligation or to repayment through another
- student loan repayment or loan forgiveness program or as a condition of employment.
- 33 (b) The board shall have the authority to approve the applications of eligible applicants
- 34 <u>submitted in accordance with rules and regulations established by the board governing the</u>
- 35 <u>student loan repayment application process.</u>
- 36 (c) The board is authorized to provide for the repayment of student loans held by recipients
- 37 <u>in consideration of the recipient serving as a faculty member of a nursing program.</u>
- 38 (d)(1) Each recipient before being granted any student loan repayment shall enter into
- 39 <u>a student loan repayment agreement with the board agreeing to the terms and conditions</u>
- 40 <u>upon which the student loan repayment is granted, including such terms and conditions</u>
- set forth in this Code section.
- 42 (2) The board shall have the power to terminate a student loan repayment agreement at
- 43 <u>any time for any cause deemed sufficient by the board, provided that such power shall not</u>
- 44 <u>be arbitrarily or unreasonably exercised.</u>

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45 (e) Each student loan repayment agreement entered into under the authority granted in this

- 46 <u>Code section shall:</u>
- 47 (1) Provide for repayment of the recipient's student loans in a total amount to be
- determined by the board, but not exceeding a maximum of \$100,000.00 or the total
- 49 <u>student loan debt of the recipient, whichever is less, to be paid out in installments made</u>
- each 12 months over a term of not more than five years. A student loan repayment made
- 51 pursuant to this Code section shall be paid in such manner as the board shall establish by
- 52 <u>rules and regulations;</u>
- 53 (2) Provide that any payment made by the board under a student loan repayment
- 54 agreement shall be made in consideration of services rendered by the recipient as a
- 55 <u>faculty member of a nursing program;</u>
- 56 (3) Provide that the board shall make a payment toward the recipient's student loans, in
- an amount set forth in the agreement, for each 12 months the recipient serves as a faculty
- member of a nursing program during the term of the agreement; and
- 59 (4) Require that the recipient shall remain a legal resident of the state as established by
- 60 rules and regulations of the board; maintain licensure as a a registered professional nurse
- 61 <u>under Article 1 of Chapter 26 of Title 43; and be employed as a faculty member of a</u>
- 62 <u>nursing program at all times during the term of the agreement.</u>
- 63 (f) The board shall adopt such rules and regulations as are reasonable and necessary to
- 64 implement the provisions of this Code section.
- 65 (g) Student loan repayment for recipients having entered into a student loan repayment
- agreement with the board pursuant to this Code section shall be contingent upon the
- 67 appropriation of funds by the General Assembly for the purposes of this Code section in
- 68 annual appropriations Acts of the General Assembly."

70 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
