A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to provide that the
- 3 governing authority of each municipality and county in this state and each board of education
- 4 which employs sworn police officers who are P.O.S.T. certified may adopt policies under
- 5 which such sworn officers, upon their retirement or upon leaving such employment as a
- 6 result of a disability arising in the line of duty, may retain his or her weapon and badge; to
- 7 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions regarding law enforcement officers and agencies, is amended by adding a new
- 12 Code section to read as follows:
- 13 "<u>35-1-20.</u>
- 14 The governing authority of each municipality and county in this state and each board of
- education which employs sworn police officers who are certified by the Georgia Peace
- Officer Standards and Training Council may adopt policies under which such sworn
- officers, upon their retirement from employment by such municipality, county, or board
- of education or upon leaving such employment as a result of a disability arising in the line
- of duty, shall be entitled, as part of his or her compensation, to retain his or her weapon and
- 20 <u>badge.</u>"
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
