The Senate Committee on Government Oversight offered the following substitute to SB 3:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to personnel administration generally, so as to require state departments, agencies,
- 3 boards, bureaus, offices, commissions, public corporations, and authorities to assess
- 4 educational, experiential, and training requirements for jobs; to identify jobs for which such
- 5 requirements can be reduced; to require efforts to reduce the number of jobs for which a
- 6 four-year college degree is required; to provide for a short title; to provide for related
- 7 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

- 10 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Reducing Barriers to State Employment 11 Act of 2023."
- SECTION 2.
- 13 Article 1 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 14 personnel administration generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 15 follows:

- 16 "45-20-22.
- 17 The Department of Administrative Services shall:
- 18 (1) Regularly assess the educational, experiential, and training requirements necessary
- 19 for each job within such department, agency, board, bureau, office, commission, public
- 20 <u>corporation, or authority;</u>
- 21 (2) Identify jobs for which the educational, experiential, and training requirements could
- be reduced from their present level; and
- 23 (3) Insofar as practicable, reduce the number of jobs for which a four-year college degree
- 24 <u>is required as a condition of employment.</u>"

25 SECTION 3.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
