# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 2 relating to personnel administration generally, so as to require state departments, agencies, 3 boards, bureaus, offices, commissions, public corporations, and authorities to assess 4 educational, experiential, and training requirements for jobs; to identify jobs for which such 5 requirements can be reduced; to require efforts to reduce the number of jobs for which a 6 four-year college degree is required; to provide for a short title; to provide for related 7 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

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#### **SECTION 1.**

10 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Reducing Barriers to State Employment11 Act of 2023."

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## **SECTION 2.**

13 Article 1 of Chapter 20 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to14 personnel administration generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as15 follows:

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## 16 ″<u>45-20-22.</u>

- 17 The Department of Administrative Services shall:
- 18 (1) Regularly assess the educational, experiential, and training requirements necessary
- 19 for each job within each department, agency, board, bureau, office, commission, public
- 20 <u>corporation, or authority;</u>
- 21 (2) Identify jobs for which the educational, experiential, and training requirements could
- 22 <u>be reduced from their present level; and</u>
- 23 (3) Insofar as practicable, reduce the number of jobs for which a four-year college degree
- 24 is required as a condition of employment."
  - **SECTION 3.**
- 26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
