**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT**

1 To amend an Act providing for the compensation of certain county officers and officials of
2 DeKalb County, approved March 31, 1976 (Ga. L. 1976, p. 3986), as amended, so as to
3 increase the salary of certain judges, judicial officers, and county officers; to provide for an
4 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act providing for the compensation of certain county officers and officials of DeKalb
8 County, approved March 31, 1976 (Ga. L. 1976, p. 3986), as amended, is amended by
9 revising Sections 2 and 2.1 as follows:

10 **"SECTION 2.**

11 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the annual salary of each of
12 the officials of DeKalb County listed below shall be the following percentages of the gross
13 salary as defined in Section 1:

- 14 (1) Judge of the Probate Court.....90%
- 15 (2) Clerk of the Superior Court.....75%

16	(3) Tax Commissioner.....	75%
17	(4) Judge of the Juvenile Court.....	90%

18 SECTION 2.1.

19 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the annual salary of each of
20 the officials of DeKalb County listed below shall be the following percentages of the gross
21 salary as defined in Section 1:

22	(1) Chief Executive Officer.....	100%
23	(2) Members of the Board of Commissioners.....	31.984326641319%"

24 SECTION 2.

25 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 3 as follows:

26 "SECTION 3.

27 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the annual salary of each of
28 the officials of DeKalb County listed below shall be the following percentages of the gross
29 salary as defined in Section 1:

30	(1) State Court Judge, Jury and Traffic Division.....	90%
31	(2) State Court Solicitor.....	90%
32	(3) Chief Magistrate.....	90%
33	(4) Associate Magistrate.....	67.5%
34	(5) District Attorney.....	100%"

35 SECTION 3.

36 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2021.

SECTION 4.

38 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
