## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 12-2-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to permit
- 2 applications and appeals procedures relative to laws enforced by the Environmental
- 3 Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources, so as to establish that persons
- 4 are not aggrieved by listings on the hazardous site inventory that occur after a certain date;
- 5 to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 12-2-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to permit
- 9 applications and appeals procedures relative to laws enforced by the Environmental
- 10 Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources, is amended by revising
- 11 subparagraph (c)(3)(B) as follows:

- 12 "(B) Persons are not aggrieved or adversely affected by the listing of property in the
- hazardous site inventory in accordance with Code Section 12-8-97 if such property was
- so listed prior to July 1, 2014, nor are persons aggrieved or adversely affected by an
- order of the director issued pursuant to Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 8 of this title, the
- 16 'Georgia Hazardous Site Response Act,' unless or until the director seeks to recover
- 17 response costs, enforce the order, or recover a penalty for violation of such order;
- provided, however, that persons are aggrieved or adversely affected if the director
- 20 (a) of Code Section 12-8-97. Any person aggrieved or adversely affected by <u>any</u> such

designates property as needing corrective action pursuant to paragraph (8) of subsection

- 21 <u>listing occurring after July 1, 2014, or any such</u> designation shall be entitled to a
