A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4,
2	1991 (Ga. L. 1991, p. 4359), as amended, so as to terminate the employment of appointed
3	officers upon such persons qualifying to seek public office; to provide for the termination of
4	employees upon qualifying to seek public office in certain circumstances; to provide for
5	related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
7	SECTION 1.
8	An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Stockbridge, approved April 4, 1991
9	(Ga. L. 1991, p. 4359), as amended, is amended by adding a new subsection to Section 2.16
10	to read as follows:
11	"(f) No appointive officer of the city shall continue in such employment upon qualifying
12	as a candidate for nomination or election to any public office. No employee of the city
13	shall continue in such employment upon qualifying for or election to any public office in
14	this city or any other public office which is inconsistent, incompatible, or in conflict with
15	the duties of the city employee. Such determination shall be made by the mayor and
16	council either immediately upon election or at any time such conflict may arise."
17	SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
