A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding law enforcement officers and agencies, so as to require the
- 3 documenting of certain information in incidents of family violence; to provide a short title;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Raesha Danielle Heard Act."
- 8 SECTION 2.
- 9 Chapter 1 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 10 provisions regarding law enforcement officers and agencies, is amended by adding a new
- 11 Code section to read as follows:
- 12 "35-1-24.
- Any law enforcement officer or agency that responds to a report of family violence or an
- incident involving an actual or alleged act of family violence, as defined in Code Section

15	19-13-1, shall prepare an incident report that, in addition to all other requirements,
16	includes:
17	(1) Whether any party to the incident involving actual or alleged family violence is the
18	subject of an active or expired protective order in the Georgia Protective Order Registry;
19	<u>and</u>

- 20 (2) To the extent reasonably obtainable, the number and nature of prior incidents
 21 involving law enforcement between the parties to the incident involving actual or alleged
 22 family violence."
- 23 SECTION 3.
- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
