A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 22 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 clinical laboratories, so as to provide for changes to provisions exempting pharmacists from
- 3 provisions of said chapter when performing certain tests; to remove a cross-reference; to
- 4 provide for reporting of tests and standards; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 22 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to clinical
- 9 laboratories, is amended in Code Section 31-22-9, relating to applicability of chapter, by
- 10 revising subsection (b) as follows:
- 11 "(b) This chapter shall not apply to pharmacists licensed pursuant to Chapter 4 of Title 26
- 12 practicing in accordance with the provisions thereof, who shall be considered practicing
- within their scope of practice, when they are performing capillary blood tests and
- interpreting the results as a means to screen for or monitor disease risk factors <u>or drug use</u>
- and facilitate patient education as authorized in Code Section 26-4-4, so long as such
- capillary blood tests are available to and for use by the public without licensure of the user
- of the test such tests. Pharmacists performing such tests shall make reasonable efforts to
- report the results obtained from such tests to the patient's physician of choice."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
