## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 17-6-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 authorization of posting cash bonds generally, furnishing of receipt to person posting bond,
- 3 recordation of receipt of bond on docket, and disposal of unclaimed bonds, so as to provide
- 4 for unclaimed cash bonds; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 

- 8 Code Section 17-6-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the authorization
- 9 of posting cash bonds generally, furnishing of receipt to person posting bond, recordation of
- 10 receipt of bond on docket, and disposal of unclaimed bonds, is amended by revising
- 11 subsection (c) as follows:
- 12 "(c) In the event that any cash bail posted pursuant to this Code section or Code Section
- 13 17-6-5 is not later claimed by the surety on such bond after a period of seven years from
- 14 the later of either the date on which the defendant was required to appear in court two years
- from the earlier of either the date of the surety being released from liability pursuant to 15
- Code Section 17-6-31 or the date of disposition of the case by the prosecutor or the court, 16
- including any appeal of a verdict or sentence, then the cash shall be paid into the general fund of the county having trial venue of the case, as in the case of forfeited cash bonds, 18
- 19 provided that the officer who accepted is in possession of such cash bail shall first have
- 20 notified the surety, by mailing notice to such surety at the last address given by such surety,
- 21 that such funds shall be forfeited if they are not claimed within 90 days following the date
- 22 of mailing of such notice. Any claim by a surety for refund of a cash bail shall include
- 23 acceptable documentary proof of disposition of the case from the prosecuting official or
- 24 appropriate court records or such other documentation as may be acceptable to the official
- 25 holding such cash bail as proof that the case has been settled."
