A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating a board of commissioners of Baldwin County, approved December

2 26, 1888 (Ga. L. 1888, p. 286), as amended, particularly by an Act approved February 26,

3 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 4786), so as to provide for staggered terms for the board of

4 commissioners; to provide for initial terms; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.** 7 An Act creating a board of commissioners of Baldwin County, approved December 26, 1888 8 (Ga. L. 1888, p. 286), as amended, particularly by an Act approved February 26, 1992 (Ga. 9 L. 1992, p. 4786), is amended by revising subsection (c) of Section 1 as follows: 10 "(c)(1) Those members of the board of commissioners serving on the effective date of 11 this Act shall serve out the terms to which they were elected and until their successors are 12 elected and qualified. 13 (2) At the November general election in 2024, members shall be elected to represent 14 each of the five commissioner districts provided for in subsection (a) of this section as 15 follows:

(A) The board members for Districts 1 and 2 elected at such election shall be elected
 to four-year terms of office and shall serve until December 31, 2028, and until their
 successors are elected and qualified; and

- (B) The board members for Districts 3, 4, and 5 elected at such election shall be elected
 to two-year terms of office and shall serve until December 31, 2026, and until their
 successors are elected and qualified.
- (3) Successors to the board members elected pursuant to paragraph (2) of this subsection
 shall be elected in the general election in the year in which the respective terms of office
 expire and shall take office on the first day of January immediately following their
 election for terms of four years and until their successors are elected and qualified.
- 26 (4) All members shall be nominated and elected pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2
- 27 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the 'Georgia Election Code.'"
