AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 31-12A-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 definitions regarding smoke-free air, so as to revise definitions; to provide for related
- 3 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Code Section 31-12A-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions
- 7 regarding smoke-free air, is amended by revising paragraph (16) and adding a new paragraph
- 8 to read as follows:

- 9 "(16) 'Smoking' means inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted tobacco
- product <u>intended for inhalation</u>, including cigarettes, cigars, and pipe tobacco. <u>Such term</u>
- includes the use of an electronic smoking device which creates an aerosol or vapor or the
- 12 <u>use of any oral smoking device for the purpose of circumventing the prohibition of</u>
- smoking in this chapter."
- 14 "(19) 'Tobacco product' has the same meaning as in 21 U.S.C. Section 321(rr) as it exists
- on July 1, 2023."

16 SECTION 2.

17 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
