A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 8 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to waste
- 2 management, so as to prohibit the distribution of certain bags made of plastic film and items
- 3 made of polystyrene foam by certain retail establishments; to provide for exceptions; to
- 4 provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
- 5 other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 8 of Title 12 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to waste
- 9 management, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

10 "<u>ARTICLE 10</u>

- 11 12-8-220.
- 12 As used in this article, the term 'exempt item' means:
- 13 (1) A bag distributed at the point of sale to:
- 14 (A) Contain or wrap uncooked meat, fish, or poultry;

- (B) Package bulk items such as fruits, vegetables, grains, or candy;
- 16 (C) Contain food sliced or prepared to order;
- 17 (D) Contain a newspaper for delivery to a subscriber;
- 18 (E) Collect trash; or
- 19 (F) Store food in refrigeration;
- 20 (2) A garment bag:
- 21 (3) A bag prepackaged for sale to a customer;
- 22 (4) A bag provided for the carryout or delivery of prepared food;
- 23 (5) A bag provided by a pharmacy to carry prescription drugs;
- 24 (6) A bag provided for the disposal of diapers;
- 25 (7) A bag provided for the disposal of animal waste; or
- 26 (8) Extruded polystyrene foam that is:
- 27 (A) Provided for medicines or other medical purposes; or
- 28 (B) Used for building or construction purposes.

- 30 On and after January 1, 2026, except for exempt items, no persons who are engaged as
- 31 <u>dealers in the sale at retail and who are subject to the collection of sales and use taxes under</u>
- 32 Part 2 of Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 shall distribute any bag made of plastic film or
- 33 <u>item made of extruded polystyrene foam.</u>
- 34 <u>12-8-222.</u>
- 35 Any person who violates any provision of this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- 36 Each distribution of a bag made of plastic film or item made of extruded polystyrene foam
- 37 that is in violation of this article shall be a separate offense."
